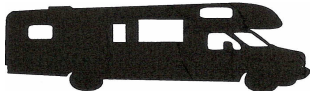

Campground Rules/ Regulations/ Best Practices

These Rules Are for All Campers

Important Check in time: 12:00 noon, Wednesday, June 24th, 2026

Check out time: 12:00 pm, Sunday, June 28th, 2026

1. In the event of a medical emergency call 911. The address of this campground is: **23627 County Road CM in the Town of Tomah.** The main office phone number is 608-372-2081. The office hours are from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. If you have any emergency, please give the operator the address of the campground as well as your site number and name. After calling 911, notify the campground hosts so that they can easily direct rescue personnel to your site.
2. If there is a weather-related emergency, you may tune to the local stations at 97.1, 96.1 or 94.5 for further information. The green exhibit building located next to the beer garden will be open; however, this is not a certified storm shelter. It would be available for cover, but you would do so at your own risk.
3. All camper units must maintain **a distance of 10 feet** from the camper units next to it. This is a state law for emergency response. There will be an inspector on the grounds at some point during the event and he will be looking for this.
4. Please be aware of carbon monoxide exhaust. Please make sure your generator or camper exhaust is not going directly into another unit. Review generator handout enclosed.
5. You **MUST** be 18 years of age or accompanied by an adult to camp. Anyone found to be breaking this rule will be asked to leave.
6. **DRINKING ON THE EVENT GROUNDS** – Anyone drinking alcohol on the grounds (whether you are 21 or 81) will have to wear a Budweiser Wristband. Keep this in mind while you are waiting in line. This would be a good time to get your wristband to avoid long lines inside to get your Ice-Cold Budweiser.
7. Dogs are allowed in the campgrounds. All dogs must be on a leash. If you bring a dog, **PLEASE clean up after it,** or you will be asked to leave. **Please Note: Dogs are not allowed in the seating area(s) for the event!**
8. Quiet time begins at midnight and goes through 6:00 a.m. This is because the pull sometimes ends late. If you feel this time is too late, please remember that this is NOT a traditional campground; therefore, peace, quiet, and privacy is NOT likely in this setting. NO LOUD music after hours – no hearing protection should be needed in the campground areas just in the grandstands...please be respectful of your neighbors!!!
9.  Campfires are allowed only to the extent that they are contained in a fire ring (maximum size 4ft in diameter). Please pick up all fire rings and wood when you leave. Please do not start a bonfire or we will have to put out! The Fire Chief can ban any fires at his discretion depending on weather conditions or other factors.
10. Alcohol is allowed in the campground; however, you must be 21 to consume alcohol, it's the law, and you must keep it in the campground. Authorities are present in the campgrounds. Dispose of all containers in designated trash receptacles.
11. ATV'S, Golf carts, and Scooters **ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE CAMPGROUNDS!** They are not allowed on the event grounds without a special permit. In some cases, if you have a medical need for transportation, please contact the main office to obtain a permit. If you have a prohibited motor vehicle in the campgrounds, you will be asked to leave with no refund.

12. There is only one electric camping unit allowed per electric site. **Sites are 20' X 40'**; you must contain all your items on that one site. If your vehicle is in the fire lane, you will be towed. Your vehicles must fit on your site. Please do not park your vehicle on someone else's site. You will be allowed up to 2 vehicle passes per site. **Additional vehicle passes may be purchased for \$10.00;** those vehicles must be parked in the overflow parking.
13. Please bring the appropriate cords and plug-ins for camping. If you are in a non-electric site and are running a generator, please be courteous to your neighbors.
14. There will be Ice for sale at the Camper Check-in area. Prices are as follows: Ice TBD/bag
15. **SHOWERS IN the CAMPGROUND:** Thunder Showers will be providing showers in the campground.
16. There will be a shuttle that will run from the campground to the pull grounds. The shuttle will pick up at the camper check-in area and will go on a loop to the beer tent area. The shuttle will tentatively run at the following times:

Thursday	4 pm – ½ hour After the Show
Fri & Sat	9 am – 1 pm 3 pm – 7 pm 9 pm until ½ hour after the Show
17. A Portable Cleaning Unit will be available to pump out your camper. The cost & signup sheet for this will be posted at camper check-in. You will need to pay when you sign up.
18. For your convenience there is a well and faucet in the campground to fill your tanks with water. This will be located across from the camper check-in.
19. **Campers!! FOR YOUR SAFETY: Please use the designated walkways to get to Rec Park (Pull Grounds). Access to the event grounds is by walking or using the shuttle. Besides the Campground driveway, there is a pedestrian gate located in the middle on the north side of the campground. This access is on private property, please use the proper behavior when utilizing this route.**
20. **PLEASE** be considerate of the people living in the homes along the campground areas. Please watch your behavior and your language as there are young children that live in these homes. If we experience problems, we may lose the privilege of camping. **PLEASE DO NOT CUT ACROSS LAWNS TO GET TO YOUR SITE.**
21. **NO FIREWORKS ARE ALLOWED IN THE CAMPGROUND. IF YOU ARE FOUND WITH THESE, YOU WILL BE ESCORTED OUT IMMEDIATELY WITH NO REFUNDS.**
22. **No Refunds given out sixty (60) days prior to the event.**

These rules are for the comfort and safety of all campers! Our camping facility and pulling grounds are patrolled by security 24 hours a day. Please remember that our sites are 20' x 40' areas; therefore, these sites are close together and should be considerate of others. All other rules may be added or changed, as we feel necessary!
